

Hall-N-Flori Sets Track, Stakes, National Season Records
In Winning Division Of \$63,100 Standardbred 2-YO Filly Trot

Delaware, OH—Hall-N-Flori and Pacific Splash captured divisions of Wednesday's \$63,100 Standardbred 2-Year-Old Filly Trot in record breaking fashion.

Hall-N-Flori set track and stakes records in winning her division in 1:58.3. The Broadway Hall filly broke Anamosa Hanover's stakes standard of 1:59.1 set in 1987 and erased Kindava Hush's track mark of 1:59. Hall-N-Flori also recorded the fastest mile of the season by a juvenile trotting filly on a half-mile track.

The victory for owner Dean Davis of Wooster, OH, was the filly's fourth win in eight starts. Vannick Gingras fired off at the start and never trailed, beating Swing Anna Cash and Cheetah Hall. Kent Sherman is the trainer.

Pacific Splash, driven by Charlie Norris, also broke Anamosa Hanover's stakes record with a 1:59 clocking, coming off the pace to win. The victory for Robert Key's American Winner filly ended a two-month losing streak. Jogging Home finished second and Final Tab Hanover third.
