Supplemental Entries

Three-year-old pacers not eligible as of February 15, 2022 may, with a payment of \$45,000, supplement to the Little Brown Jug. Supplemental declaration fees are due with the intent to start in the Race Office by 10 a.m. five (5) days before date of race (Sundays counted). – Saturday, September 16.

Field Limitations

If more than 24 horses declare in to start, only the (24) twenty-four horses with the highest lifetime earnings will be allowed to start. Horses eligible as of February 15, 2023 will have preference over any Supplemental entries. All paid in fees will be refunded to those not permitted to start.

Entries and Starting Fee

The starting fee of \$7,000 is due by 10 a.m. three (3) days before date of race (Sundays counted) – Monday, September 18.

Detention/Retention

All Little Brown Jug starters are subject to the retention policy of the Delaware County Agricultural Society and are require to report to the Detention Barn by 11 a.m. – Tuesday, September 19.
